BICo scandal

BICo was a council-run company that managed two match-day car parks, supposedly to reinvest the cash in the local community, but a preliminary report shows among other things, unreceipted takings, discrepancies between expected and reported parking levels and the use of cash for things such as providing a job for the one of the councillors involved in the running of the company.

The report was only made public after the intervention of the Government Information Commissioner

At the elections in May voters will be required to provide Photo ID such as a Passport, Drivers License, National Travel Pass or Senior Railcard. Alternatively you may also apply for a postal vote. For details ring the City council on 0151 233 3000.
