Brecksides Park



Neighbours have contacted us about their disappointment that Brecksides Park Play Area still remains closed. Due to our constant lobbying, the Council have confirmed they have submitted a report to have capital invested in repairs with the Play Inspector actively getting quotes for these works.

Rocky Lane

A shop on Rocky Lane has continuously left furniture on a public pavement, restricting access to both those in wheelchairs and those using push prams. The Council have confirmed that they are sending out a formal highways notice to ensure the pavement remains clear.
