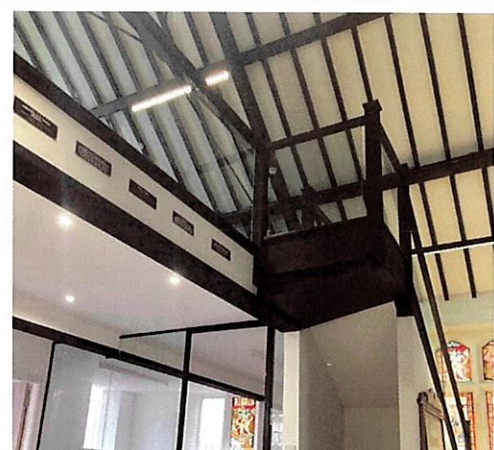

Dear Neighbours,

You may have read that the Boundary Commission have finalised their recommendations for new Single Member Wards.

From May 2023 you will be in a new **Stoneycroft Ward** that will cover New Road to Queens Drive, from Millbank to Portelet Road / Sark Road including all Green Lane, Snaefell Avenue, Moscow, Kremlin Russian Drives, Richland, Rockbank, Bankfield, Guernsey, Brelaide, Menstone Roads, Stoneycroft Crescent and Close.

As I live in the heart of the area I wanted to let you know I will be standing for election for this new ward in **May 2023**. I would also assure you that Cllrs Billy Lake, Joe Dunne and myself will continue to work as a team across the whole community.

For those who do not know me I thought it would be appropriate to share some of my background with you:

I studied at Warwick University obtaining a degree in Business Studies.

I became a **Personnel Manager at Plessey Telecommunications** working at Edge Lane and Huyton sites for 30 years serving in many roles such as recruitment, managing the software apprentice scheme, pensions administration and employee welfare.

During this time I was elected for the Tuebrook and Newsham Park Ward and later for the Tuebrook and Stoneycroft ward serving for now **42 years**.

I campaigned to demolish the Carlton, Save the Parkview GP surgery, Scrap the West Derby Road Congestion Scheme re-open Peter Lloyd Sports Centre and so much more.

In 2000 I was one of the founding Trustees of the **Tuebrook Hope Group** where I currently work part time as Manager.

During the Covid lockdown I led a dedicated team of volunteers delivering over **£54,000 worth of hampers** to older neighbours isolating or with vulnerable health conditions.

I have been the Trustee responsible for fund raising at **Stoneycroft United Reformed Church** and currently Christ Church, Tuebrook.

This year I have led the fund raising and design for a renovated Youth Hub, Training Centre and exhibition space as well as a renovated Chapel for worship at Christ Church Chapel, Buckingham Road. If you have not been in please call by for a coffee or tea.

As a ward councillor I have organised numerous community clean up and skip days, cooking and first aid classes for children at local schools, community health events and vaccinations days, money and debt advisors and individual support with three confidential weekly surgeries.
